North West Regional Hospital redevelopment

Work continues at the North West Regional Hospital Cancer Centre and DEM Redevelopment with stage one nearing completion.

The 1600 square metre facility will handle general and refrigerated freight, offer warehousing & distribution services and provide container storage.

It will also increase the amount of freight carried by rail, making our roads safer.

Construction of the new Island Fresh Distribution Centre located at Connector Park, Launceston is underway.

Blundstone Arena

VOS is honoured to be building the new \$30m Western Grandstand and Administration Centre at the Blundstone Arena.

This project consists of the demolition of existing grandstands, construction of a new Western Grandstand (4,500 seats), new 3 level administration block, basement car park, concourse, site works and landscaping.

Project completion is due in advance of the World Cup Cricket events to be held in early 2015.

Our mission is to make a positive and lasting difference by helping and empowering individuals, families and communities both locally and overseas.

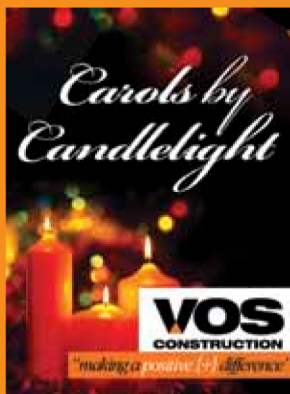
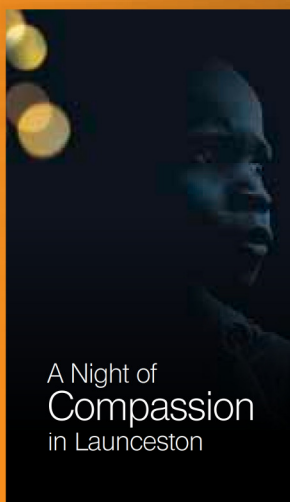
The VOS Foundation fulfills its mission in different ways.
